

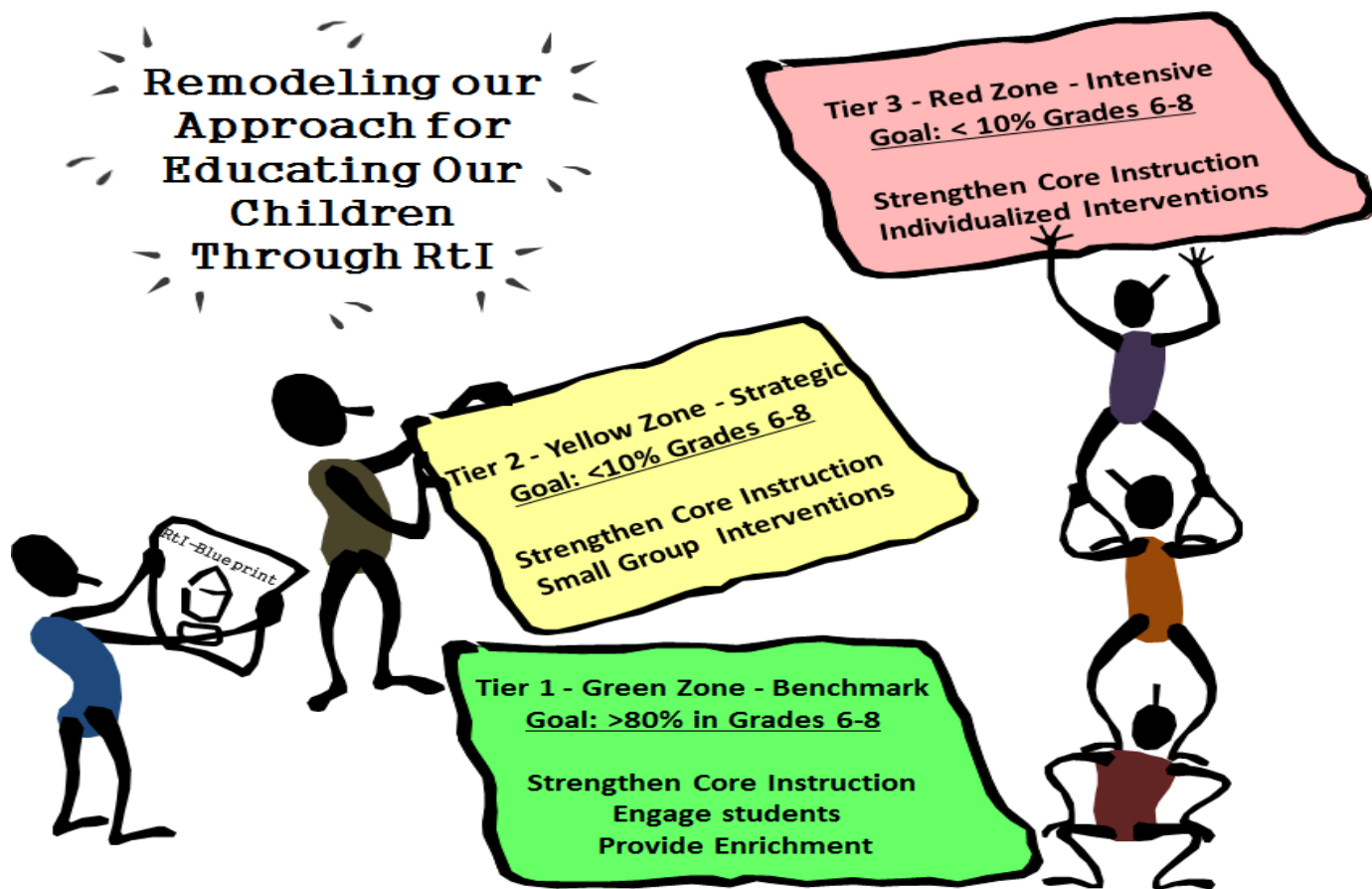

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Yellow/Red (Combined - Orange) - Tier 2+3 - Strategic/Intensive Interventions (64 Students)

A team of teachers work with students in small groups and individually to provide reading and math support. Groups meet every week, Monday through Thursday, for 40 minutes. Ongoing assessment builds an effective foundation for student learning.

Green - Tier 1 - Benchmark (Approximately 15-16 Students Per Adult)

Benchmark groups are designed to engage students through a rich learning opportunity while strengthening core understanding and skills. Research shows that a highly engaged teacher leads to highly engaged students. As a result, our teachers are developing curriculum units that embed reading, writing, math and science skills. Students are immersed in this area for nine weeks before rotating to a new group and learning opportunity.
